

Ice Lantern's dazzling fire-and-ice combination warms up home entertaining indoors or outside.

Invented in Norway, where winters are frosty, comes the fascinating Ice Lantern mold. The product, is star-shaped with a center cavity in which a candle can be set after making the frozen lantern. Warm candlelight glowing through the icy facets creates an unforgettable, mood-setting centerpiece. When candlelit frozen Ice Lanterns are also placed outdoors near entries and walkways, arriving guests receive a spectacular welcome.

Making an Ice Lantern is as easy as making ice cubes. Fill it with water, freeze for at least 12 hours and un-mold at room temperature. For a creative touch, sink flowers, herbs and various decorative objects, such as party favors into the water before freezing. A few scoops of ice cream in the center make a party in itself and a favorite of youngsters. The possibilities are endless and only limited by imagination. If using the Ice Lantern indoors, be sure to place a bowl directly underneath the lantern to collect the melting ice.

Two sizes are available. The large model holds 5 pints of water and will remain frozen about 5 hours at room temperature. The small model has a 3-pint capacity and remains frozen about 3 hours at room temperature.
